Agenda Item: Administrative Rule Revision Proposal

Background Info:

Animal Health is be proposing revisions to the following Administrative Rules:

- 32.3.1203 Isolation of Rabid or Suspected Rabid Animals
- 32.3.1205 Animal Contacts

32.3.1203 – Replace accredited veterinarian with licensed veterinarian. Many small animal veterinarians in Montana are not deputy state veterinarians. This change recognizes the significant work that non-accredited small animal veterinarians do for rabies management in Montana.

32.3.1205 – Revise management of animals exposed to a rapid or suspected rabid animal to be consistent with the recently released Compendium of Animal Rabies Prevention and Control. These changes reflect current science showing the response to vaccination of an animal past due for rabies vaccination, as well as better data about the incubation period of the disease.

Recommendation: Approve proposed changes for filing with SOS to initiate rule change process.

Agenda Item: Request to fill Animal Health Compliance Tech Position

Background Info: The employee in position of Compliance Tech (56300012) has submitted her resignation, and Animal Health Division is requesting to fill this vacancy.

The Import/Export and Disease Control office in the Animal Health Division requests to fill this position which has key tasks of:

- Organized deputy accreditation trainings for incoming veterinarians
- Reviewed and issued 94 biological permits collecting \$8,627 in fees
- Coordinated communication on 14 rabies positive cases, quarantined 2 counties, and 9 individuals. Tasks for this item include: consultation with the Public Health on pre and post exposures to evaluate the level of disease exposure and appropriate quarantine measures, and geographically track cases.
- Reviewed and issued 54 seasonal grazer permits for Montana producers and for Border States' producers to move cattle into Montana for grazing.
- Reviewed certificates for compliance and issued permits for 1,147 Canadian cattle to be imported in FY 2015.
- Managed 88 quarantines in FY 2015 for animals imported.

The risks of not filling this position would include:

- A workload that cannot be met by four remaining staff members.
- Permits issued would increase from 276 per person monthly to 346 per person monthly.
- Impaired ability to identify and execute a timely response to a disease outbreak that could have major economic and/or Zoonotic implications.
- Misinformation provided by temporary or under-trained staff causing serious liability to the state and the department, inaccurate information could be provided to private veterinarians impacting their practice negatively.

This position was previously vacant in late 2015, and Animal Health requested to fill it in October 2015. We request permission to hire at an hourly rate of \$14.00-\$16.00 per hour
