Background Info:

USAHerds is a software system used by the Animal Health Division for managing and tracking animal imports, quarantines and brucellosis program testing. The program is also used by several other states. A hands-on workshop is held once a year to help end users use new features and better use the program through collaboration with others.

Animal Health is requesting out of state travel approval for two individuals (Evaleen Starkel and Sara Sylte) to travel to the USAHerds User Group Annual Meeting.

The conference is scheduled for April 26-28 in Denver, Colorado. The detailed breakdown is below, but the total costs are estimated to be \$2508. Travel for both individuals will be covered out of the Animal Disease Traceability Cooperative Agreement.

Background Info:

Animal Health will be proposing revisions to the following Administrative Rules:

- 32.2.401 Department of Livestock Animal Health Division Fees
- 32.3.2006 Intrastate Movement of Cattle: Identification
- 32.3.460 Quarantine and Retest of Suspect Animals in Negative Herd
- 32.3.221 Special Requirements for Alternative Livestock as Defined in 87-4-406, MCA
- 32.4.402 Elk-Reed Deer Hybridization Tests
- 32.4.601 Importation of Alternative Livestock
- 32.2.401 Include language that will allow the Department to charge for shipping and handling expenses of forms and biologics shipped to veterinarians.
- 32.3.2006 Revise age specifications for animal requiring back tagging at livestock markets from 24 months to 18 months to be consistent with federal Traceability standards.
- 32.3.460 REPEAL. The language in this administrative rule is duplicative to the administrative rules that cover reportable diseases in Montana and the Department's quarantine authority.
- 32.3.221 Clarification that only sexually intact animals require a negative brucellosis test for importation.
- 32.4.402 Provide current language for certification of elk as free from red deer hybridization. The current ARM requires a negative test and has outdated timelines for test requirements. The new language will allow for animals either test negative or originating from a herd registered and certified through the North American Elk Breeder Association.
- 32.4.601 Cleanup of the language in this ARM following the changes to 32.4.402. Strike language regarding permits that is duplicated in other areas of ARM.
