### Health Certificate - issued within 30 days of entry

Official identification, testing and statements listed on health certificate

Import Permit Numbers are Required for Hand-Written Paper Health Certificates ONLY

#### **Official Identification**

All show/exhibition sheep require official identification

Official USDA ear tag, breed registration tattoo, scrapie premises ID tag, or premises tattoo



# Show/Exhibition Sheep

Testing and Documentation Requirements

### Testing

- No testing required
- Required Statement: "While in Montana, these sheep will be used for exhibition only and cannot be sold or used for breeding."

### Scrapie

Required Statement: "The animals in this shipment were not exhibiting clinical signs associated with scrapie at the time of the examination."

## **Prohibited Species**

(Including but not limited to) Mouflon, Mouflon cross, Barbary, Tahr, Chamois, Aoudad, Barbados, Hawaiian, and Black Hawaiian.
