

Montana Department of Livestock Import Regulations Elephants



Health Certificate
Issued within 30 days of entry

Official identification and testing is required to be listed on the health certificate.



Import Permit Required

Elephant import permits cannot be issued over the phone. Please send health certificate, testing documents, and approved FWP permit via email to obtain an import permit.

Official Identification

All Elephants require a microchip. The full microchip number must be listed on the health certificate.



Fish, Wildlife, and Parks (FWP) Permit.

Import Requirements

ARM 32.3.227

Negative Screening Test

All elephants require a negative screening test approved by the state veterinarian within 12 months prior to importation into Montana.

Trunk Washes

- Elephants with no known exposure to TB culture-positive animals in the previous five years require three negative trunk washes and culture within 12 months prior to importation.
- Elephants exposed to TB culture-positive animals in the previous five years require three negative daily trunk washes and culture within 90 days prior to importation into Montana.
