

Cattle Official Identification



Animal Identification Number (AIN) "840" Tags

Issued to owners and accredited veterinarians. AIN tags begin with the official country code ("840" for the U.S.) followed by 12 digits. AIN tags are available with radio frequency identification technology that allows them to be readable visually and electronically.

Beef Cattle

All sexually intact animals require official ID except:

- Animals moved directly to an approved tagging site with the statement on the CVI: *"Animals in shipment are moving to an approved tagging site."*
- Beef calves less than 6 months of age with their dams if the dams are identified.
- Beef heifers less than 18 months of age for feeding only with the statement on the CVI: *"Heifers are for feeding only."*



Dairy Cattle

All animals require official ID, regardless of sex, and the ID must be listed on the health certificate



Sport/Rodeo Cattle

All animals require official ID, regardless of sex, and the ID must be listed on the health certificate
