Llamas, Alpacas, and Camels



Health Certificate - issued within 30 days of entry

Official identification, testing and statements listed on health certificate



Import Permit Numbers are Required for Hand-Written Paper Health Certificates ONLY

Official Identification

Official USDA ear tag, breed registration tattoo, or microchip

All animals require official identification



Llamas, Alpacas, and Camels

Import Requirements

Brucellosis

Sexually Intact Animals

- One negative brucellosis test within 30 days prior to importation, except nursing young accompanied by a test negative dam

Tuberculosis (TB)

Sexually intact animals 2 month of age and older

- One negative TB test within 60 days prior to importation
