Meat Breed Goats



Health Certificate - issued within 30 days of entry

Official identification, testing and statements listed on health certificate



Import Permit Numbers are Required for Hand-Written Paper Health Certificates ONLY

Official Identification

Official USDA ear tag, tattoo, breed registration tattoo, scrapie premises ID tag, premises tattoo, or microchip

All sexually intact goats of any age require official identification

All goats over 18 months of age require official identification



Meat Breed Goats

Import Requirements

Brucellosis

Sexually intact animals 6 months of age and over
One negative brucellosis card test within 30 days
prior to entry

Scrapie

Required statement: *“The animals in this shipment
were not exhibiting clinical signs associated with scrapie
at the time of the examination.”*
