Health Certificate - issued within 30 days of entry

Official identification, testing and statements listed on health certificate

A noncontrolled species is a live, exotic wildlife species, subspecies or hybrid of that species that may be possessed, sold, purchased, or exchanged in the state without a permit, from Fish, Wildlife, and Parks
