

# Montana Department of Livestock Import Regulations **Domestic Sheep**



## Health Certificate - issued within 30 days of entry

Official identification, testing and statements listed on health certificate

Import Permit Numbers are Required for Hand-Written Paper Health Certificates ONLY

#### **Official Identification**

All classes of sheep over 18 months of age

Sexually intact sheep of any age

Official USDA ear tag, breed registration tattoo, scrapie premises ID tag, or premises tattoo



## **Domestic Sheep**

Testing and Documentation Requirements

### Brucellosis

Rams 8 months of age and older

- One negative Brucella ovis ELISA test within 30 days prior to import **OR**
- Originate directly from an official state recognized Brucella ovis free flock

### Scrapie

Required Statements: "The animals in this shipment were not exhibiting clinical signs associated with scrapie at the time of the examination."

## **Prohibited Species**

(Including but not limited to) Mouflon, Mouflon cross (AKA Barbados), Barbary, Tahr, Chamois, Aoudad, Barbados, Hawaiian, and Black Hawaiian.
