<u>Motion/Vote:</u> Ed Waldner moved, and during discussion verbally amended his motion, to have Dan Turcotte confer with processors of Grade A milk doing business in Montana to confirm that they will date milk in compliance with Montana milk labeling laws, obtain written confirmation from those processors of the date of their compliance, and then, with the approval of Ed Waldner and John Lehfeldt, write to retailers to provide the retailers of the compliance date from the processers.

<u>Substitute Motion:</u> John Scully moved that the motion include a requirement that Mr. Turcotte also send a letter to processors and retailers requiring compliance with the labeling laws.

John Scully withdrew his substitute motion.

Nina Baucus seconded Ed Waldner's motion.

The motion passed.
